Fire Dept – Clintonville meeting last week. 4 years out for a new firetruck order; fire calls, EMT assist went up. Ambulance Service – process of hiring a candidate for clerical. The person in consideration can do the clerical portion and their current position. Running at full staff. OT hours are not needed to keep the Ambulance staffed.

Highways and Roads – Gravel Roads being graded; grader is in our area right now.

Ryan – Ford Garage – Met with City of Clintonville, City is responsible for 159 feet on W Reinke road. Reinke has never been a good road, last year the Town ground the blacktop and had gravel laid down. Caused financial impact to my business. Feels the Town needs to take care of the issue in a timely manner. If action is not taken legal action will be taken. Bart VanStraten – spoke about the condition of the road also.

The city is going to start the engineering process from Hwy 45 to 3rd street the 159 feet of city will not be done until 2027 or 2028.
